Sally will investigate availability of first aid courses, especially any oriented towards cycling injuries and health. Possible sources are Cycling UK, British Red Cross, and St John's Ambulance.</p> <p><i>Update 23<sup>rd</sup> Nov '22: Sally has found Greenbox and Red Cross. Lisa will ask Andrea for input.</i></p> <p><i>Update 28<sup>th</sup> Nov '22: Andrew emailed Committee: "I had a look at the Green Box first aid, specifically for cyclists, and it looked quite good. £495 for up to 12 people seemed reasonable.
